FREE 5 MINUTE PARKING!!

- Commencing MONDAY the 10th of August, Bridge Street becomes a " P 5 Minute" pickup zone. This means that during the signposted times, drivers are only permitted to park and leave their vehicle for no more than 5 minutes when they park legally against the kerb within the two signposts.
- The zone will be 24 metres long which will accommodate 4 parked standard vehicles.
- The zone will operate from 8.00am to 9.30am and 2.30pm to 4.00pm on school days only.
- For the zone to operate smoothly and efficiently, parents parking in the zone must adhere to the 5 minute limit. It is recommended that children wait near the Bridge Street school gates and walk to the vehicles.
- Remember, it is only a five minute zone and council have stated they shall enforce this parking change, **so please keep it moving.**
